Gamete

◆ An organisms reproductive cells. Sperm in males and eggs in females.

Binary Fission

- Prokaryotes reproduce through asexual reproduction.
- Binary fission is a form of asexual reproduction that produces identical offspring. The parent passes exact copies of all of its DNA to the offspring.

Gene

• A segment of DNA that codes for a protein or RNA molecule.

Chromosomes

 Made of DNA and the proteins associated with DNA found in the nucleus of the cell.
Visible only during cell reproduction.

Chromatids

• One arm of the chromosome

Centromere

• The attachment point where the two chromatids are attached to form a whole chromosome.
