Changes in Chromosomes

Trisomy

A condition caused by cells gaining more than two copies of a chromosome.

Nondisjunction

When one or more chromosomes fail to separate properly causing a condition called trisomy.

Mutations

 Changes in an organism's chromosome structure

Deletion

 A section of the chromosome has been removed

Duplication

 A section of the chromosome has been copied more than once

Inversion

• A section of the chromosome has been flipped over.

Translocation

• A section of the chromosome has been moved to another part of the chromosome.

Cancer

• A problem in the cell's checkpoints causing uncontrolled growth of cells (tumors).
