

Heart Related Illnesses

- Atherosclerosis – fatty deposits that harden and narrow the coronary arteries.
- Coronary Artery Disease – Narrow Coronary Arteries
- Myocardial Infarction – Heart Attack
- Thrombus – Blood clot in the vessel

- Balloon Angioplasty – Procedure for opening blocked arteries
 - Stent – permanent implant into the artery to prevent further plaque build-ups
 - Congestive Heart Failure – left ventricle enlarges and weakens due to being overworked from hypertension

-
- Aneurysm – outward bulge in blood vessels due to hypertension
 - Stroke – caused by a ruptured blood vessel (aneurysm) or an embolism lodged in a vessel preventing blood flow to a portion of the brain.
